

Welcome to the Dedication Ceremony for the Flowing Wells Irrigation District's groundwater treatment facility.

The new 900 gpm groundwater treatment facility, located at the existing Roger Road pumping and storage facility site, was installed by Flowing Wells Irrigation District in response to an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) standard for arsenic of 10 parts per billion and as part of an Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) cleanup effort at the Miracle Mile Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) Site.

The project was financed in part through the Water Infrastructure Finance Authority (WIFA) and ADEQ.

The Miracle Mile WQARF Site is bounded approximately by Wetmore Road to the north, Flowing Wells Road to the east, Prince Road to the south, and La Cholla Boulevard to the west. The main contaminants of concern at this WQARF site are trichloroethene (TCE) and chromium. The WQARF Program investigates and cleans up areas with groundwater or soil contamination around the state.

The arsenic treatment portion of the project was recently honored with the EPA's 2006 Aquarius Award for the innovative use of SRF funding for sustainable public health protection. The project had been nominated by WIFA for furthering the goals of the Drinking Water Act through exceptional planning, management and financing.
